A very special thank you goes out to Meeting members and attenders who donated winter items for the unhoused in our local communities. Some of the winter clothing items went to the Salvation Army in Norristown who run shelters. Other items were donated to TLC For The People. TLC is part of a monthly event held in Norristown on the third Saturdays of the month where those in need may come and select items they might need. We had a generous amount of donations. As of this writing, 16 sets of gloves, 13 scarves for children and adults, 20 beanies and hats, 4 ear muffs, 18 pairs of socks, 2 emergency thermal blankets, and assorted personal care items.
